

House and sports court order San Gian

Scope

This house rules is part of the access to the sports court of **FC Celerina** and applies to the entire club area with its associated facilities.

Every trainer and user of this sports facility is obliged to know the house rules and to implement and respect them.

Objectives of the house and sports court regulations

1. Prevent hazards or damage to persons, material and property.
2. Ensure a trouble-free course of events.
3. Protect the club grounds from damage and contamination.

Recognition / bonding

The board, officials, coaches and visitors acknowledge the regulations of these house rules with the receipt of a key, but at the latest with the access to the sports grounds as binding.

Dedication

The sports area serves primarily to host football matches and trainings. In addition, after consultation with groundskeeper and board other sports events and non-sporting events can be performed.

Cleaning

Once or twice a week, the clubhouse is chargeable at the expense of the club cleaned. The leaving of a clean wardrobe, utility rooms and FCC Beiz must be seen by all teams of the association as a matter of course. The path from the cloakroom to the square and back leads up the stairs to Samedan.

Leaving the areas / clubhouse

- The last one controls and is responsible for closing all doors and windows, switching off all lights and turning off all taps and showers.
- Training / Match: Everyone is required to clean their shoes at the cleaning pool after training or match.

Behavior on the sports court

1. Within the sports court (Piazza da San Gian), each visitor must behave in such a way that no one else is harmed, endangered, disabled or harassed.
2. All entrances and exits as well as the escape routes are to be kept clear. This means that no



vehicles may be parked or left standing on the way to the football /soccer field. In addition, access is only permitted to those who have received an access permit from the municipality of Celerina. This may basically be used only for access roads such as material intake and discharge or the like. For trainings, games etc., please use the public car parking area San Gian.

3. Smoking in the clubhouse and on the sports field is strictly prohibited. There is a smoking area in front of the entrance to the clubhouse. All cigarette butts must be collected.

Lawn / gates / material

- After the training / match, the football goals are always to be provided at the designated place.
- The barriers in the field are to be respected and may not be removed without the consent of the controller.
- The coaches are responsible for the material and must ensure that all balls, balls, rods, etc. are stored in the material room after training.
- After the matches, the used material must be supplied immediately (linesmen flags, corner flags, gates, anchorages for the gates, water buckets, etc.) Anything that is left behind can cause major damage to the lawn mower, at the expense of the FCC.
- Goal training and goal kicking exercises must not be performed in 5-meter space. Thus, the lawn is spared in this area.
- The trainers should not always do the exercises during the training in the same location, but distributed, in order to use the turf evenly.
- Damage or irregularities must be reported to the material manager immediately.

Liability

1. Entering and using the sports area is at your own risk. For personal injury and property damage caused by third parties, no liability is accepted.
2. Accidents or damage must be reported immediately to the coach, groundskeeper or board of directors of FC Celerina.
